Dear. Dr. Tannen,

Dr. David Cundiff is under my care for the treatment of sprain of left hip with subtrochanteric bursitis and tendentious. He also has myofascial pain in the left gluteal muscles, pyriformis, and iliopsoas. Over the past six-months, he has three relapses of this condition which required him to walk with crutches. Most recently, he has been on crutches for the past two-weeks. I injected the left hip bursa with decadrone LA today, so hopefully, this will speed his recovery. However, until the acute inflammation resolves, he must avoid weight bearing on the left leg.

Due to the current acute inflammation episode and the relapsing nature of Dr. Cundiff's condition, I am advising him not to take on the extra duties of ward medicine attending in May 1994. The stress of him working above 40 hours per week would likely aggravate his tendentious

I will continue to monitor and treat his condition. Thank you.
